#### Treasurer Report - Jill Edelson

Hi. Attached is the budget. The first sheet shows all the amounts by program that we have spent and brought in. Near the end is the checkbook that you can also see each item being deposited and checks written. And the last sheet is the Treasurer's Report that shows what we projected for the budget and what we actually

budgeted. The only differences to note are that we were over in the Hospitality meal for the Back to School Lunch by \$69.14 and the butterfly was not added to the budget. That will need to be adjusted in the other meals to reflect that difference.

#### **Programs Report**

#### **PTACHC Report:** Reginald Avery

Meetings first Monday of every month – new President is adamant meetings won't last past 9:15 pm Cut back on CAC and union etc presentations to keep timely – have presentations for school board and superintendent reps

Only ones can vote are presidents and delegates – anyone is welcome to attend though – currently at Homewood

Will do a special presentation on heroin because it's a big problem now in our schools and area Working with Chinese American group to bring mandarin Chinese and Korean into the schools, right now we have French and Spanish

School Policy groups and committees you can volunteer for, i.e. school calendar committee CA – limbs trimmed – don't know if it was done – need school to come in and clean up before CA can come in and do their part

Howard County police department out now on the paths – on bikes and motorized vehicles – paths are off limits from 10 pm to 6 am

Offer from MD PTA – come to school to do presentation on PARCC – get \$200 for PTA to buy supplies – will be in October – questions was asked if we could sponsor the event but try to have it at a bigger venue because our school is so small

Principal's Update: Mr. Diaz

Thank you to everyone for family file completion – 99% completion at this point

Focus this year – school improvement plan – submitted and reviewed in October – focus in K-2, need to be on-grade level reading so that when entering grades 3-5 – right on grade level when enter 3<sup>rd</sup> grade

RIGOR – access to advanced level programs

Focus on staff engagement – 98% completed in first day

Identify student group to focus on – English language learners is our focus - alignment

Howard County grounds dept and CA rep – focus on grounds in front of the building – plan is to cut away underbrush 20 feet in on all sides, taking it in to central canopy – purpose to have a site line from the front of school/offices to the street or more space out front

Construction of the canopy – possibly starting 3<sup>rd</sup> or last week of Oct
